JUN 22, 2018: OVERNIGHT FLIGHT Departure from the United States.

JUN 23, 2018: ST MALO Bienvenue en France! Upon arrival, meet your Encore Tour Manager and transfer to St. Malo where you will check into your hotel and have dinner together at a local restaurant. This evening, take a walk with your Tour Manager through the quaint streets of this walled city. (D)

JUN 24, 2018: ST MALO In the morning board your coach for a visit to the lovely island monastery of Mont St. Michel. This medieval abbey, once an important pilgrimage site, is surrounded by water at high tide. This afternoon, rehearse for your first performance as part of a joint concert with the local choir in Cathedrale Saint Vincent (pending approval). Enjoy dinner together this evening. (B,D)

JUN 25, 2018: TOURS This morning depart for Tours. En route, stop in Villandry for lunch then enjoy a walk through the lovely gardens surrounding the Château de Villandry. Arrive in Tours and check into your next hotel. Enjoy dinner together tonight. (B,D)

JUN 26, 2018: DIJON This morning, visit King François I's spectacular royal Château d'Amboise and Clos Lucé, where Leonardo da Vinci chose to spend his final years. Continue to Burgundy, where you will have a wine tasting! Your final destination is Dijon, where upon arrival you will check into your next hotel and enjoy dinner together. (B,D)

JUN 27, 2018: DIJON Upon arrival, take a walking tour of Dijon, the former capital of the Dukes of Burgundy, with a local guide. See the historic downtown, famous for its glazed tiled rooftops, half-timbered

houses and magnificent period architecture. Make sure you taste the local mustard! This afternoon, rehearse for your next performance as part of a joint concert at the Cathedral Saint Benigne de Dijon (pending approval). Enjoy dinner together tonight. (B,D)

JUN 28, 2018: PARIS Paris awaits you today. This afternoon, a guided sightseeing tour that takes you past some of the most famous attractions in Paris. Your expert local guide will show you the iconic Eiffel Tower, the magnificent Arc de Triomphe at the top of the Champs-Élysées, Napoleon's final resting place at Les Invalides and the Gothic wonder of Notre Dame. This evening, enjoy an illuminated dinner cruise along the Seine. (B,D)

JUN 29, 2018: PARIS This morning you will explore the Louvre and discover the many famous masterpieces that call it home. See the Mona Lisa, the Winged Victory and the Venus de Milo as you wander through the galleries. From its beginnings as a royal fortress to its current status as the world's most visited art museum, the Louvre has long been at the center of Parisian culture and home to a collection of 35,000 works of art from around the world. This afternoon, rehearse and perform your final concert on your tour at Saint Germain des Prés Paris (pending approval). Enjoy your final dinner together this evening. (B,D)
